Background:

Foreign Trade Zone #244 (FTZ) was established in August 2000. As a requirement of the grant of authority, the March Joint Powers Authority (March JPA) must submit an annual report updating the Foreign Trade Zones Board on the volume of merchandise that was imported to and exported from the zone. The information contained in the FTZ #244 Annual Report covers the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The following statistics are particularly notable:

- 1,803 People employed in FTZ #244 during 2020; and
- \$124.6 Million in merchandise was exported from the zone in 2020, and
- \$2.1 Billion of merchandise was shipped through FTZ #244 in 2020.

Since the previous annual report, pending applications and interested entities include Toolots, Inc., Trafilea, Hellman Worldwide Logistics, Alliance Operating Services, and Ta Chen International, Inc. Also in 2020, the following company was approved for FTZ activation: Skechers-Minor Boundary Modification.
