Background

United States Veterans Initiative (U.S.VETS) is the nation's largest nonprofit provider of comprehensive services to homeless and at-risk veterans. With eleven facilities in five states and the District of Columbia, U.S.VETS provides vital services such as case management, housing, work force development, health and wellness, and individual support to over 20,000 veterans each year.

Status

- February 2011: The March Joint Powers Commission issued:
 - o \$8 million in Housing Tax Allocation Bonds
 - o \$2 million in Low- and Moderate-Income Housing
 - o Donated 8 acres for veterans housing (long-term, no cost land lease).
- November 2011: U.S.VETS was approved by the March Joint Powers Commission, for the development of a 323 unit, 401 bed transitional housing campus, within eight buildings, for homeless U.S. Veterans.

 - \$8.1 million Veterans Housing and Homeless Prevention Program

2017 – 2022 Completed Phases:

- Phase I: Support Services and Housing for veterans and family members:
 - Building 2 (2017): 116 Studio Apartment Units.
 - Building 3 (2018): 6 1 Bedroom Units & 16 2 Bedroom Units
- Phase II: Support Services and Housing for veterans:
 - Building 1 (2022): 15 2 Bedroom Units & 1 Residential Manager Unit

> Phase III (Approved February 2024): Transitional and Permanent Supportive **Housing:**

24 Transitional Housing Units & 44 Permanent Supportive Housing Units
